QR GRAMMAR AND CREATIVE WRITING-2

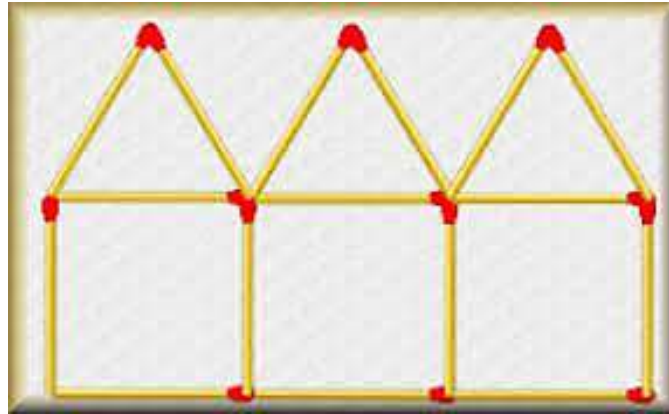
MATHEMATICS

SUBJECT ENRICHMENT ACTIVITY: Tree of Tales (Do the Activity in Scrap File)

Objective:

Students will understand family relationships and how different generations are connected. They'll also get to know more about their family history.

Materials Required:

- A4 Sheet
- Sketch Pens or Crayons
- Photos of family members.
- Scissors and glue.
- Stickers or other decorations.

Steps:

1. **Draw the Tree:** Draw a big tree with branches. Each branch will represent a different generation.
2. **Add Family Members:** Start with the student at the base of the tree. Draw or paste a picture of themselves here.
3. **Parents and Siblings:** On the next branch up, add the student's parents and any siblings.
4. **Grandparents:** Above the parents, add the student's grandparents.
5. **Extended Family:** Continue adding aunts, uncles, cousins, etc., on appropriate branches.
6. **Decorate:** Allow students to decorate their family tree with stickers, markers, or other decorations.
7. **Label:** Make sure each person is labelled with their name and relationship to the student.
