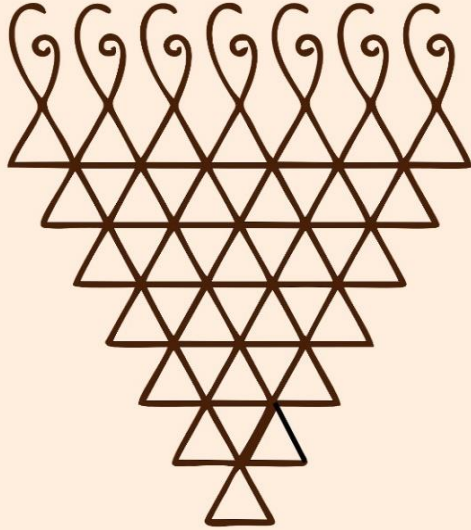

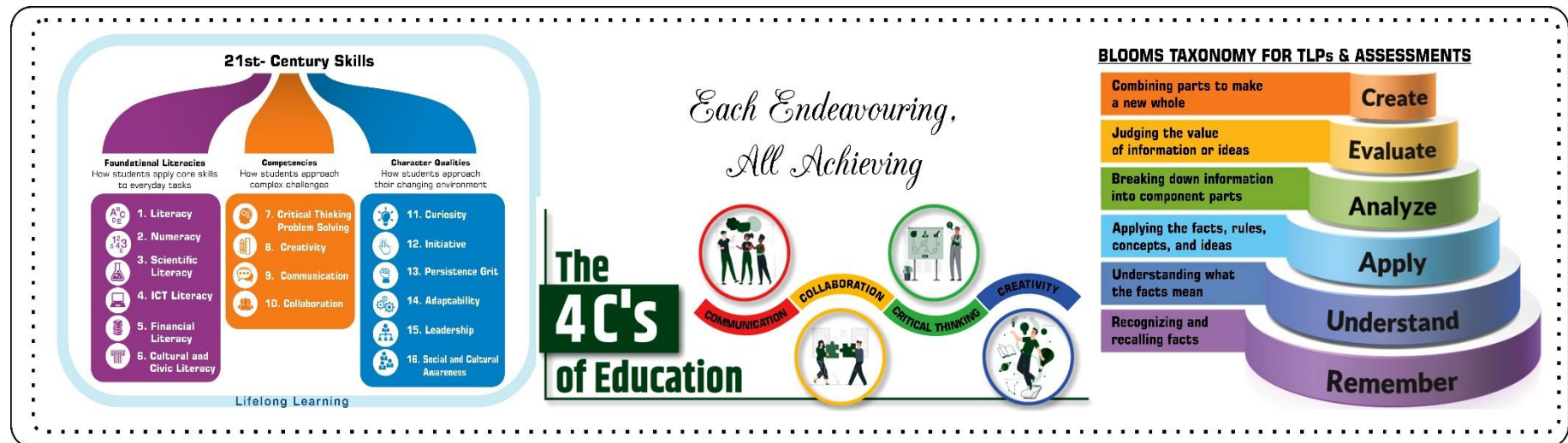

PREFACE
